"What Mean These Stones?" Joshua 4

THE STORES WERE THE EVIDENCE OF A **LASTING** EXPERIENCE

The miracle of Jordan was to have a permanent effect on Israel.

THE STORES WERE TO BECOME THE **CENTER** OF THEIR LIVES.

We need a place of **REMEMBERING**.

The stones reminded the people of the faithfulness of their covenant God (Deut. 8:2, 11, 12, 14, 18, 19)

Remembering the cross is a powerful deterrent to backsliding (2 Pet. 19)

We need a place of **READJUSTMENT**.

We examine our present spiritual status in the light of that past experience.

THE STONES WERE A **WITNESS** TO OTHERS

"He has put a new song in my mouth – Praise to our God; Many will see it and fear, And will trust in the Lord" (Psalm 40:3).

They were the **PAST** reaching out to the **PRESENT**

There ought to be present evidence of our past blessings. There ought to be in our life something that makes our children ask about our experience with the lord.

They were **PROPERLY PLACED**.

And as we learn to follow through with our experience and go on to maturity in Christ, we will become a memorial to the mighty, saving hand of the Lord.
